

DESCRIPTION OF SONY HVC-2800

The SMF HVC-2800 Tricon camera from Sony achieves superior low-light sensitivity and faithful color reproduction. It employs a top quality 8:1 variable speed power zoom f1.4 lens with macro close-up focusing. 1½ monochrome electronic viewfinder for monitoring your recordings and for playback. Operational information is presented in the viewfinder viewing area. Includes white balance switch with sunlight, incandescent and automatic light settings. This camera also allows you control over the iris opening and executes fades between scenes. You can also vary the color hue in your playback picture. Supplied with a high quality detachable external shotgun microphone. Stereo recording at the camera available through left and right channel mini plugs. Earphone jack switchable between camera and VCR. Sensitivity switch for high, low and automatic light setting. The included professional metal carrying case keeps everything protected.
